


Figure 7: Artist Laloai Peseta, "Sacred Space" 2012, Manamea Gallery




Figure 10: Artist Jonathan Gladding, "1.5 to Stay Alive," source Panos Caribbean 2012




Figure 14: Artist Fatu Feu'u, Poutasi, painting acryclic and oil pen on canvas 2010
